### Course details

A free, 15-hour online course offering teacher support over 3 weeks/4 weekends to help teachers prepare candidates for Trinity College London's ISE II Extended Writing, task 4 at B2 (CEFR).

The course has challenging and inspiring resources with tasks to encourage a reflective approach. Course participants can make contributions to discussion forums, learn from colleagues and participate in activity-based learning involving the creation of tasks. Much of the course can be done at one's own pace, although there are some group activities that are best done within the same time frame.

The main aims are:

- To raise the candidate's awareness of the different genres and text types that are specified in the 'extended writing' task for ISE II
- To reflect on ways to improve written responses
- To provide resources, teaching ideas and practical tips for preparing candidates for the 'extended writing' task at ISE II
- To help participants develop and share their own teaching ideas for improving their students' writing skills.
