Course details

The overall aim of this course is to help teachers develop, refine and enhance their understanding of current approaches to teaching and learning reading and writing skills at B1 (CEFR) and reflect on how these are connected.

Quest for best: Developing Reading and Writing Skills at B1 level is ideally suited for teachers who hold qualifications that entitle them to teach in Spanish state schools and 'escuelas concertadas' or are on the Spanish list of interinos/as.

Work will include:

- examining ideas and teaching strategies to help develop learners' skills
- planning and designing activities to use in the classroom
- sharing activities and teaching experiences
- raising one's awareness of how performance can be improved and assessed.
