Introducción

Sobre Trinity Stars

Trinity Stars: jóvenes intérpretes en inglés, fomenta la enseñanza y el aprendizaje del inglés a través del teatro, la música y la interpretación. Es un *Award* grupal destinado para niños entre 3 y 12 años.

Con Trinity Stars, los niños aprenden a **utilizar el inglés a través de canciones, poemas, historias y obras cortas** y la representan frente al experto de Trinity Stars, lo que da los alumnos una sensación de satisfacción, logro y éxito.

Estas **experiencias positivas estimulan el aprendizaje de idiomas:** los resultados del aprendizaje muestran una mayor confianza en sí mismos y una mejora en la memorización del lenguaje aprendido.

Trinity Stars permite que los grupos participantes se presenten a diferentes niveles:

- •Stage 1: para niños con 6 meses-1 año de experiencia con el inglés
- •Stage 2: para niños con 1 a 2 años de experiencia con el inglés
- •Stage 3: para niños con más de 2 años de experiencia con el inglés

•School Show: para edades variadas con la participación de todo el colegio

Activity Plan: Healthy Habits

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching healthy daily routines. The activities include expressive mime, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

Healthy daily routines; learnt first as commands and then in full sentences in a song.

Performance Aims

Singing, expressive movement and mime.

Materials required for this activity

- A toothbrush and toothpaste
- An apple
- A skipping rope or a ball
- Soap
- Shower gel
- A hairbrush
- An empty box

Optional: a bowl of water, a towel and some earth or sand in a flower pot.

Stage One

Activity Plan: Weather

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching and talking about weather. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- Talking about the weather
- Speaking in chorus

Performance Aims

- Expressive movement and mime
- Using musical instruments to create mood and atmosphere.

Materials required for this activity

Different coloured cloths of paper to adapt as costumes [optional].

Activity Plan: Colours in Nature

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching colours and how to associate colours with natural phenomena. The activities include expressive mime, movement to music, singing, circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- To learn the colours
- To associate the colours with natural phenomena

Performance Aims

- Expressive mime
- Movement to music

Materials required for this activity

- Coloured cards
- Images of various natural phenomena [sea, sky, trees, leaves, fruit flowers etc]

Activity Plan: Farm Animals

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching animal vocabulary and how to associate animals with sound and movement. The activities include expressive mime, movement to music, singing and project activities.

Language Aims

- Farm animal vocabulary
- Speaking in chorus

Performance Aims

- Expressive movement and mime
- Using musical instruments to create mood and atmosphere

Materials required for this activity

- Musical instruments
- Card
- Glue
- Scissors
- Flashcards
- pegs or paper clips
- Coloured pens or pencils

Activity Plan: How Plants Grow

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching garden and plants vocabulary and associating growing and plants with movement and sound. The activities include expressive mime, movement to music, playing musical instruments and project activities.

Language Aims

- Vocabulary: seed, ground, leaves, sun, rain, big, small, green, brown, yellow, gardener
- Learning about plants growing
- Speaking in chorus

Performance Aims

- Expressive movement and mime
- Using musical instruments to create mood and atmosphere

Materials required for this activity

- A pot
- A bag of planting soil
- Some fast-growing seeds
- Water

Activity Plan: The Ugly Ducklings

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching animals vocabulary through the folk tale of the Ugly Duckling and using mime and movement. The activities include expressive mime, games and project activities.

Language Aims

- Vocabulary: ducks, swans, pond and any other animals you wish to introduce into the performance
- We can...
- Where's Mummy?

Performance Aims

- Expressive movement and voice
- Choral dialogue

Materials required for this activity

No compulsory materials required

Activity Plan: The Funny Puppets

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching parts of the body vocabulary using music and movement. The activities include expressive mime, movement to music and project activities.

Language Aims

- Parts of the body vocabulary
- Group interaction through choral dialogue

Performance Aims

- Expressive mime
- Dance and movement
- Using musical instruments

Materials required for this activity

- Musical instruments
- Paints

Stage Two

Activity Plan: Wild Animals

In this activity plan you will learn to teach the names of wild animals while promoting in-group interactions through choral dialogue. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- Vocabulary: names of wild animals
- In-group interaction through choral dialogue

Performance Aims

- Improvisation
- Expressive movement and mime
- Conveying meaning through facial expressions
- Using music to convey mood and atmosphere
- Use of costumes or masks [optional]

Materials required for this activity

Pictures or flash cards of the wild animals you wish to teach

Activity Plan: Little Red Riding Hood

In this activity plan you will learn to tell the story of Little Red Riding Hood through a song or chant. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

To tell the story of Little Red Riding Hood through a song or chant.

Performance Aims

- Group enactment of a sequence of events
- Improvisation
- Expressive movement and mime
- Creating mood and atmosphere

Materials required for this activity

- A basket
- Items to go in Little Red Riding Hood's basket [for example an apple, a cake, some flowers]

Activity Plan: Funny Family

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching the present continuous, rooms in the house and revising members of the family. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- To talk about present actions using the Present Continuous
- To learn the rooms of the house
- To revise members of the family

Performance Aims

- To express actions through mime
- To create atmosphere through props or mime

Materials required for this activity

- Pictures of family groups
- Card to make paper dolls or use a printable paper doll
- Tape to divide classroom up into different rooms
- Props to use in the performance

Activity Plan: The Life Cycle of a Butterfly

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching the present continuous, rooms in the house and revising members of the family. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- Learning about the life-cycle of a butterfly
- I can/I can't (modals expressing ability)

Performance Aims

- Improvisation
- Expressive movement

Materials required for this activity

- Flashcards or pictures
- Paper
- Paint

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching toys vocabulary and how to associate toys with sounds and movement. The activities include expressive mime, games, singing, circle time and project activities.

- Expressive movement and sound
- In-group interaction through choral dialogue
- Use of costume (optional)

Materials required for this activity

- Toys
- Flashcards
- Cardboard box
- Cardboard
- Ribbon
- Paper
- Coloured pencils or pens

Activity Plan: The Echo

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching about echoes and expressing ability. You will also learn about how playing with sounds and language. The activities include expressive mime, improvisation, group and individual interactions, games and project activities.

Language Aims

- I can...

- Expressive movement
- Improvisation
- Group interaction through choral dialogue

Materials required for this activity

No compulsory materials required

Activity Plan: The Picnic

You will learn about teaching food vocabulary, talking about the weather and temperature. You'll also learn about how to associate food with sounds and movement. The activities include expressive mime, improvisation, group and individual interactions, games and project activities.

- Food
- Hot/cold
- Insects
- Weather

Performance Aims

- Mime
- Expressive movement
- Improvisation
- Group interaction through choral dialogue and individual contributions

Materials required for this activity

- A tablecloth
- A cardboard box
- Paper or plastic cups

Activity Plan: Day and Night

In this activity plan you will learn to teach daily routines while revising the o'clock times. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- To talk about daily routines
- To learn or revise o'clock times
- Vocabulary: bat, owl, fox, sun, moon, daily routines [I get up, I go to school]

Performance Aims

- Improvisation
- Expressive movement
- Conveying meaning through mime
- Singing
- Creating mood and atmosphere
- Group enactment of sequence of events

Materials required for this activity

- Cardboard sun
- Moon
- Bat
- Owl and fox shapes
- Sun colouring template: Print and then let the children colour and glue onto card.

Activity Plan: Magic Carpet

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching places by using 'I can see...', 'There is/there are...'. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Language Aims

- Talking about places using 'I can see...'
- There is/there are...

Performance Aims

- Improvisation
- Creating mood and atmosphere through movement, mime and sound.

Materials required for this activity

• A rug or a tablecloth. You could have several so that all the children can do this activity at once.

In this activity plan you will learn to teach comparatives through the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears as well as through new words and actions. The activities include performance elements, movement to music, singing and circle time and project activities.

Activity Plan: Goldilocks and the Three Bears

Language Aims

- Comparatives
- New language: bowl, porridge, hard, 'just right'

Performance Aims

- To tell the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears through words and actions
- To speak in chorus

Materials required for this activity

- Props for the performances: Three chairs of varying sizes
- Three plastic bowls and spoons
- Chairs covered with sheets to make them look like beds.

In this activity plan you will learn about teaching new vocabulary about the sea and encouraging learning of the vocabulary through sounds, movement and imagination. The activities include expressive mime, improvisation, games, dance, singing and project activities.

- Vocabulary: ship, mermaid, pirate, treasure island

Performance Aims

- Improvisation
- Creating mood and atmosphere through movement, mime and sound.
- Choral and personal interaction through dialogue

Materials required for this activity

Pictures of:

- An old fashioned sailing ship
- A desert island
- A treasure chest
